Citizens of Coolidge:

Due to extreme drought conditions we are experiencing the City of Coolidge is beginning Stage One of our Drought Contingency Plan. The reason for this is our supplier for water is also going into Stage One of their Drought Contingency Plan.

In order to conserve the available water supply and protect the integrity of water supply facilities, with particular regard for domestic water use, sanitation and fire protection, and to protect and preserve public health, welfare, and safety and minimize the adverse impacts of water supply shortage or other water supply emergency conditions, the City of Coolidge is asking each household to voluntarily reduce you total water usage by 10 percent.

Voluntary Water Use Restrictions:

- A. Water customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to Sundays and Thursdays for customers with a street address ending in an even number (0,2,4,6, or 8), and Saturdays and Wednesdays for water customers with a street address ending in an odd number (1,3,5,7, or 9), and to irrigate landscapes only between the hours of midnight and 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight on designated watering days.
- B. All operations of the City of Coolidge shall also adhere to the water restrictions .
- C. Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes.

The City will notify you of any further water restrictions, or of the discontinuation of the Drought Plan.
