Mayor Tonia Bruckner called the Coolidge City Council Meeting to order in Regular Session at 7:03 p.m.

New Business

- Approval of Minutes from May 10th & May 22nd, 2023: Logan Allcorn made the motion to approve the minutes. Katherine Hayes seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
- Payment of the Bills: Bill Torp made the motion to approve the bills except the bill from City Attorney. Logan Allcorn seconded. Voting as follows:
For: Bill Torp, Logan Allcorn and Katherine Hayes seconded. Against: Rhonda Ivy, Ami Bauer. Three in favor. Motion carried.
- Purchase of Altitude Valve for Water Tower: Logan Allcorn made the motion to approve the purchase of the altitude valve, paying out of grant money if possible. If it is not covered under grant, pay from water/sewer account. Ami Bauer seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
- City Office closed for June 19(Juneteenth Federal Holiday): Ami Bauer made the motion to close office. Katherine Hayes seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
- City Auditor: Logan Allcorn made the motion to table discussion. No auditor found. Katherine Hayes seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
- Water Loss Issues: Logan Allcorn made the motion to obtain bids for a leak detection service. Bill Torp seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
- Service Fee Charge on Vacation Accounts: Ami Bauer made the motion to charge \$36.00 per month for all accounts placed on vacation effective August 1st, 2023. Bill Torp seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
- Meters purchased by customers outside city limits before installation of digital meters: Ami Bauer made the motion to not give customers money back from purchase of their (old) water meter. All customers received an upgraded(digital) meter at no cost. Rhonda Ivy seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
- Nuisance Ordinance: Logan Allcorn made the motion to approve the Nuisance Ordinance which will go into effect August 1st, 2023. Katherine Hayes seconded. Five in favor. Motion carried.
