

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 06-07-84A


SUBJECT: FIREWORKS

FIREWORKS: Definitions for the purpose of this article, the following shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning. Any firecrackers, cannon crackers, skyrockets, torpedoes, roman candles, sparklers, squibs, fire ballons, star shells, or any other substance in whatever combination by any designated name intended for use in obtaining visible or audible pyrotechnic display, and such terms shall include all articles or substances within the commonly accepted meaning of fireworks, whether herein specifically designated and defined or not.

It shall now be lawful to set off fireworks within the City Limits of Coolidge under the following conditions.

- 1) No fireworks are allowed to be used at all if a burn ban is being enforced.
- 2) In the case of no burn ban being enforced, then fireworks are permitted between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. The one exception to this Ordinance is on New Years Eve, the shut off time will be 12:30 a.m.
- 3) Fireworks may only be set off at designated area.
 - a) The designated area will be the Old Football field located on HWY 171 N.
 - b) The City of Coolidge is not liable for any damage or injuries from individuals setting off fireworks.
- 4) All trash must be picked up after fireworks have been set off.
- 5) Fire-truck must be present while fireworks are being set off.
- 6) The penalty for violating any portion of this ordinance shall be no more than \$500.00 and the confiscation of fireworks.
