

AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE 06-07-84D

SUBJECT: TRASH BURNING

- 1) ADDITIONAL ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE BURNED OR ALLOWED TO BE BURNED:
 - a. Cannot burn: Electrical insulation, treated lumber, plastics, non-wood construction/demolition materials, heavy oils, asphaltic materials, potentially explosive materials, chemical wastes, and items containing natural or synthetic rubber.
- 2) Burning may not be started earlier than 1 hour after sunrise; it also must be concluded on the same day by an hour before sunset at the latest.
- 3) Burning shall not be commenced when surface wind speed is predicted to be greater than 6 mph.
- 4) Keep fires downwind of, or at least 300 feet away from any neighboring structure that contains sensitive receptors. (Structure containing sensitive receptor(s) – a man made structure utilized for human residence, business, or the containment of livestock). This requirement may be waived only with the prior written approval of whoever owns or rents the adjacent property and either resides or conducts business there.
- 5) The waste must-
 - Come from a property that is designed to be a private residence.
 - Be burned on the property where it was produced. For example, kitchen garbage, untreated lumber, cardboard boxes, packaging, clothing, grass, leaves, and branch trimmings.
 - Be monitored during burning by an adult with a means of extinguishing the fire.
- 6) Any fires left unattended, especially after dark, are illegal and property owners can be fined.
- 7) Fine amount.
 - a. Not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500).
